The Draw

As specified on the Badminton England website, because of the number of entries received, the draw has been split into Silver and Silver Xtra sections for the boys' and girls' singles. Players have been allocated to the Silver Star section as follows:

- all graded players were put into the Silver Xtra section
- any remaining places were allocated to the highest ranked ungraded players on the Badminton England November 2011 ranking list

Note that selections for the Silver Xtras and seedings are based on the grading and ranking lists available at the **closing date** of the tournament. Some of you have been upgraded since then, but this has not been taken into account in the draw, nor does it affect your eligibility to play.

BADMINTON England Regulations for Pooled Tournaments

The method of deciding the winner of a group depends on the format of play.

- 1) In a group where each match is one game only, where setting is not permitted, the winner shall be:-
 - a) The person/pair who wins most games.
 - b) If two players/pairs have won the same number of games the winner of the game between them.
 - c) If 3 or more players/pairs are still equal....the player/pair from among them for whom points won minus points lost is the greatest.
 - d) If two players/pairs are then equal the winner of the game between them.
 - e) If there is no winner under (d), or if three or more players/pairs are equal the player/pair from among them who wins the most points.
 - f) If two players/pairs are still equal the winner of the game between them.
 - g) If there is still a three-way tie the Referee must use his/her discretion.
- 2) In a group where each match is the best of three games, the winner shall be:-
 - a) The person/pair who wins most matches.
 - b) If two players/pairs have won the same number of matches the winner of the match between them.
 - c) If three or more players/pairs are equal the player/pair from among them for whom the number of games won minus games lost is greatest.
 - d) If two players/pairs are then equal the winner of the match between them.
 - e) If 3 or more players/pairs are still equal the player/pair from among them for whom points won minus points lost is the greatest.
 - f) If two players/pairs are still equal ... the winner of the match between them.
 - g) If three or more players/pairs are still equal the Referee must use his/her discretion.

Regulations for Automatic Upgrading 2011-12

GRADE 1

Players will be upgraded automatically, at the appropriate date, to Grade 1 if they:

- a) At all age groups the player must win a group containing at least one Grade 1 player in a Gold singles event or defeat a Grade 1 player in the knock-out stages.
- b) Win a BADMINTON England Silver U17, 15 singles event with a minimum of 24 players.
- c) Reach the final of a BADMINTON England U17, 15 Silver singles event with a minimum of 48 players.
- d) Win two BADMINTON England U17, 15 Silver singles events with a minimum of 12 players
- e) At Under 13 only a player will be upgraded to Grade 1 if they win a **Silver Xtra event**.

GRADE 2

Players will be upgraded automatically, at the appropriate date, to Grade 2 if they:

- a) At all age groups the player must win a group containing at least one Grade 2 player in a Silver singles or defeat a Grade 2 singles player in the knock-out stages.
- b) Win a BADMINTON England Bronze singles event with a minimum of 24 players.
- c) Reach the final of a BADMINTON England Bronze singles event with minimum of 48 players.
- d) Win two BADMINTON England Bronze singles events with a minimum of 12 players.
- e) At Under 13 only a player will be upgraded to Grade 2 if they win a Silver Singles event with a minimum of 12 players.

GRADE 3

Ungraded players will be automatically upgraded, at the appropriate date, to Grade 3 if they:

- a) The player must win a group containing at least one Grade 3 player in a BADMINTON England sanctioned singles event or beat a Grade 3 player in the knock-out stages
- b) Reach the quarter-finals of the singles in a BADMINTON England sanctioned age group tournament with a minimum 48 players
- c) Reach the semi-finals of the singles in a BADMINTON England sanctioned age group tournament with a minimum 24 players
- d) Reach the finals of the singles in a BADMINTON England sanctioned age group tournament with a minimum 12 players

UNGRADED

Players will now only be upgraded on four dates:

October 28th 2011, December 16th 2011, February 24th 2012 and July 20th 2012

NB. These conditions are for automatic upgrades. The Committee has the right to upgrade players who have not fulfilled these criteria if they feel that the upgrade is justified.
