## BADMINTON ENGLAND SILVER UNDER 13 INFORMATION

**Silver** tournaments are run by County BAs on behalf of BADMINTON England and are open to all except Under 13 Grade 1 players (see BADMINTON England website for details). The preliminary rounds will be played in pools and most will not have a mixed doubles event. Some Silver tournaments could be two-day events.

**Note:** Should a Silver tournament, which is scheduled for the same day as a Bronze tournament, have less than 8 entries in a singles event, the Tournament Committee may combine the Silver and Bronze Entry for that singles event. At the knock out stage, the group winners will compete for the Silver tournament Medals, and the group runners-up for the Bronze tournament medals. In the doubles events, the Tournament Committee may combine entries if the number of pairs is less than six.

**Please consult the list of tournaments on the front of entry form to check these details for the event you are entering, including details of the Tournament Secretary and County Badminton Association hosting the event.**

### CONDITIONS of ENTRY:

- A separate entry form **MUST** be completed for each tournament.
- This completed form together with the correct entry fee must be sent to the appropriate **Tournament Secretary by the closing date.**
- Whilst every effort will be made to check all entry forms, it is ultimately the responsibility of the player to ensure that they comply with entry regulations. Ensure that the forms are completed **CLEARLY** and in full (in particular the name of the specific tournament you are entering). Illegible or incomplete entries may be ignored.
- **Late entries** will only be accepted at the Referee's discretion and if numbers permit. **A late entry fee of £5.00 per player** will be imposed. In case of dispute the postmark may be used as evidence.
- **BOTH partners MUST submit an entry form.** If you have no partner and would like to enter a doubles event, please write '**Partner Required**' in the space for 'Partner's Name'. The Tournament Committee will make every effort to find you a partner but cannot guarantee to do so.
- **Refunds** not dealt with directly at the tournament should be applied for in writing to the appropriate tournament secretary within one month of the date of the tournament.
- **A list of accepted players** together with venue details and arrival times will **be posted on the BADMINTON England website** at least seven days prior to the event. If you would like written confirmation then you must enclose a **C5 (229x162mm)** stamped addressed envelope with your entry (larger envelopes will require higher postage). If not received, please contact the relevant Tournament Secretary as shown on the front of the entry form.
- **IF THESE DETAILS SHOW THAT A STAMPED ADDRESS ENVELOPE IS REQUIRED (SAE) OR YOU CANNOT ACCESS OR DO NOT WISH TO RECEIVE AN E-MAIL ACCEPTANCE LETTER YOU MUST ENCLOSE A C5 STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE (229 x 162 mm) WITH YOUR ENTRY.**

**ENTRY FEES: Boys & Girls Singles £11-50; Level Doubles £10-00; Mixed Doubles £10-00.**

### TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. **Under 13 Silver tournaments are open to Under 13 Grade 2 players or below, providing they were born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1997.**
2. Where entry levels need to be restricted the Tournament Committee will use the following criteria:
  - No late entries will be accepted
  - Known form, using the grading and ranking lists posted on the BADMINTON ENGLAND website on the entry closing date.
  - Age. If the above do not provide a clear list of players to be rejected, the borderline players who fall outside the age group will be omitted first.
3. **Provided that at least 36 hours notice is given to the Tournament Secretary**, competitors who may be prevented from playing by illness, injury or other unforeseen cause, shall have their entry fees returned less a £5 handling charge. The Tournament Committee shall have the right to enquire into the cause of the withdrawal and withhold any refund.
4. No tournament will start before 9 am and no player will be required to start a match after 8 pm on a Saturday and play should finish no later than 7 pm on a Sunday.
5. All tournaments are run in accordance with BE Regulations (see website). Clothing must be acceptable badminton clothing and its suitability, within the regulations, will be at the discretion of the Referee.
6. Games will be best of 3 to 15 rally points extended to 21 if required. Intervals will be permitted at 8 points and the end of each game sufficient for the players to take a drink and towel down, but no advice or coaching may be given at any time during a match.
7. All semi-finalists will receive a medal.
8. The Tournament Referee/Committee will set the order of play in each tournament and reserve the right to cancel a tournament and/or amend these conditions, in particular the format of play if circumstances dictate. Any amendments will be notified to entrants.
9. BADMINTON England requires all players and attendees at their Tournaments to agree to abide by BADMINTON England policies and codes of conduct, and as such fully recognise and adhere to the principles of the BADMINTON England Child Protection Policy.
10. Anyone wishing to **photograph or video at a tournament** must obtain the Referee's permission. Players (or their guardians) will be given the opportunity to withhold their permission by completing the appropriate statement on their acceptance letter and handing it in to the Referee's desk on their arrival.
11. Yehlex feather shuttlecocks will be used exclusively in Silver Tournaments.
12. The Tournament Referee's decision in all matters relating to the tournament shall be final.
