A record breaking number of schools have entered the 2008/09 Center Parcs National School Championships. Schools from across the Warwickshire and Birmingham area have entered a total of 211 teams in to the competition compared to only 20 teams last year. The first rounds of local competitions start in November with the winning schools progressing to the county finals in January where they will compete to reach the West Midlands regional final in Stoke-on-Trent.
